

Basic Navigation: Scrolling

1 As you scroll or search within your Code, the **GPS Bar** at the top of the page keeps track of where you are in the Code

2 Arrows on the **GPS Bar** allow you to move forward and backward in your Code

3 To get back home click **Code** tab on Navigation Bar

4 Jump directly to a specific subsection of the Code by clicking the subsection number. Hovering over a subsection reveals the section and subsection in the Code

5 Use the selection box to activate the **Tool Bar**
