


Monthly Incident Comparison 2015 to 2014

During **April** 2015, Village of East Troy Police Officers responded to or handled **184** incidents. This compares to **April** 2014 when officers handled **217** incidents.




Adult Cases referred to the District Attorney's Office – 19

These included Reckless Injury, Recklessly Endangering Safety, and Possession with Intent to Deliver.




Juvenile Cases referred to the District Attorney's Office – 2

These included Battery and Disorderly Conduct




Municipal Citations – 8

14-16 APRIL. Attended a conference focusing on crimes against children. I attended sessions focusing on the growing epidemic Heroin is bringing to communities and ways to understand the crimes that surround addiction. I also attended sessions focusing on updates to the forensic interviewing of children.

27-29 APRIL. Attended a training that instructed law enforcement on a new method for interviews/interrogation, with an emphasis on acquiring admissions of guilt from individuals suspected of crimes against children. This method was amazing and I feel additional officers should be sent to this training. The technique outlines steps to utilize rationalizations rather than accusations.

Deputy Chief-

This will be my monthly report for April 2015.

I completed and filed 2 vehicle forfeiture proceedings related to narcotics arrest; these vehicle both were used in the commission of possessing controlled substances with the intent to deliver. During the month of April I also assisted the Walworth County Drug Unit with a controlled buy of 1 pound of marijuana.

On April 6th 2015 I arrested an individual after a traffic stop for possession of a schedule II controlled substance with intent to deliver.

On April 20th 2015 I arrested two individuals for POCS and drug paraphernalia; both subjects were on probation for drug offenses and held on probation holds.

On April 10th I arrested a subject for possession of THC after a traffic stop was conducted for speed.

On April 22nd I arrested two individuals for possession of THC and drug paraphernalia after responding to Brolen Park for a suspicious vehicle; one of the subjects in the group had an active warrant and was on probation for battery and held on a probation hold.
