



During August 2016, Village of East Troy Police Officers responded to or handled 225 incidents. This compares to August 2015 when officers handled 222 incidents.




Adult Cases referred to the District Attorney's Office – 19




These included but are not limited to Trespass to Land, 2nd Degree Sexual Assault of a Child, Child Enticement and Battery.

Juvenile Cases referred to the District Attorney's Office – 0



Chief-

This will be my monthly report for August of 2016.

On August 16-19 I attended The Wisconsin Narcotics Officers Association Conference in Green Bay.

On August 20, during a traffic stop, I arrested a female passenger for possession of THC and another passenger on an outstanding warrant with Racine County.

On August 21, during a traffic stop, I arrested a female for possession of a schedule II controlled substance and male passenger for possession of a crack cocaine pipe.

On August 31, after responding to a rescue call, Deputy Chief Swendrowski and I arrested a male subject for possession of a synthetic cannabinoid with intent to deliver, resisting arrest, disorderly conduct and a probation hold. The subject overdosed while driving on the Interstate and was called in by his passenger who thought he was having a stroke. A total of 22 packages of synthetic drugs were recovered with an approximate weight of 100 grams.

During the month of August I also attended my monthly drug unit meeting and participated in several traffic grants.
