The Village of East Troy Police Department has installed a Prescription Medication Drop Box in the lobby of the Police Department at 2015 Energy Dr. It will be available for public use during normal business hours. The Prescription Medication Drop Box is a secure, safe, anonymous and environmentally friendly way to dispose of unused prescription medication. Drugs are a serious health risk to children, pets and may be abused if not disposed of properly. Proper drug disposal is a high priority for the police department. This is a free service and available to Village of East Troy residents.

The Prescription Medication Drop Box is only for disposal of unused prescription and over-the-counter medication. Please leave the medication in the original containers if possible or place in a sealed zip-top plastic bag. Labels on medicine bottles can be removed in order to remain anonymous.

- **INHALERS**
- **HYDROGEN PEROXIDE**
- **AEROSOL CANS**
- **HOUSEHOLD WASTE/CREAMS/OINTMENTS**
- **INFECTIOUS/BIOHAZARD MATERIAL**
- **PERSONAL CARE PRODUCTS**
- **STREET DRUGS, IE Cocaine, Heroin, Marijuana**
