



During February 2016, Village of East Troy Police Officers responded to or handled 175 incidents. This compares to February 2015 when officers handled 154 incidents.




## Adult Cases referred to the District Attorney's Office –16




These included but are not limited to: Disorderly Conduct, Battery and Possession with Intent to Deliver.


## Juvenile Cases referred to the District Attorney's Office – 2

**Deputy Chief Swendrowski**, attended the Wisconsin Chiefs of Police Winter Conference.
