




Monthly Incident Comparison Chart 2013 and 2014.

During January 2014, Village of East Troy Police Officers responded to or handled 193 incidents. This level of activity compares to January 2013 in which officers recorded 276 incidents.




Charges/Individuals Referred to the District Attorney's Office -11

During January 2014, these included Child Abuse Intentionally Causing Harm, Resisting Police and Battery.




Criminal Cases Sent to the District Attorney's Office-3




Juvenile Cases Referred to the District Attorney – 1

These are juvenile cases due to the severity or a repetitive offender, are referred to the District Attorney. During January, a 1st Degree Sexual Assault of a Child.




Municipal Citations- 11

Municipal citations are issued by officers for violation of municipal ordinances and are heard by Judge Cotter in the Village of East Troy Municipal Court. Initial appearance is normally the first Wednesday of the month and trial call is the third Wednesday of the month.

Incidents of Note:

On January 1 at 2:41 am police responded to a bar on the square for a reported disorderly subject. On arrival officers were directed to an intoxicated subject by other patrons in the bar. When officers approached the subject he refused to cooperate and became belligerent. When officers attempted to place the subject in custody he resisted arrest, by pulling away from officers struggling with officers. The subject was taken into custody and transported to Lakeland Medical Center for a jail clearance and was later turned over to Walworth County Jail staff.

On January 5 at 3:47 pm police stopped a vehicle in the area of I-43 and Hwy 20 for several traffic violations. When officers approached the vehicle they could smell the odor of cannabis coming from the vehicle's interior. The occupants of the vehicle were requested to exit the vehicle and a subsequent search revealed the presence of cannabis and drug paraphenila in the vehicle. The occupants were cited and released with a court date.

On January 7 at 4:00 pm police met with a complainant at the police department regarding a landlord/tenant issue. The complainant (tenant) told police he had been living in a room on Fremont St. and had been locked out of the house. He stated he had returned to find his belongings in the garage. When police spoke to the landlord he advised there had been problems for several months with the tenant and when he went into the rented room he discovered drug paraphernalia. The landlord stated he did not want any issues with the tenant and just wanted him out. Both the tenant and landlord were advised to seek legal counsel.

On January 13 at 3:19 am police stopped a vehicle in the area of Church and Main St. for traffic violations. When police approached the driver a strong odor of an intoxicating beverage was noted on the driver's breath. A Field Sobriety Test was administered which the driver failed. The driver was taken into custody for OWI 1st offense.

On January 21 at 9:30 am police were called to the East Troy School District regarding a possible child abuse situation. When police met with the victim he stated he was afraid to go home and had been struck several times with an object by his father. The subject revealed several old and new brusing on his body. During a subsequent investigation the child was transported to Child Protective Services and the father was taken into custody and related child abuse charges were filed.

On January 23 at 10:53 am police were called to a business on Energy Dr. for a subject who had been maintaining a piece of equipment and had become stuck between the operating parts of the equipment. On police arrival CPR was being administered and the victim was transported to Waukesha Memorial Hospital where he died. OSHA was contacted and arrived to conduct a workplace death investigation.
