


July 2013

During July 2013, Village of East Troy Police Officers responded to or handled 215 incidents. This level of activity compares to July 2012 in which officers recorded 332 incidents.



During July 2013, Village of East Troy Police Officers issued citations or referred to the Walworth County District Attorney's Office the following:


**Charges/Individuals Referred to the District Attorney's Office -3**

During July 2013 a Resisting, an Officer and 2 Bail Jumping charges were referred to the District Attorney's Office.




**Criminal Cases Sent to the District Attorney's Office-2**

During July 2013 a Disorderly Conduct and a Bail Jumping were sent to the District Attorney.




### Juvenile Cases Referred to the District Attorney – 3

These are juvenile cases due to the severity or a repetitive offender, are referred to the District Attorney




### Municipal Citations- 13

Municipal citations are issued by officers for violation of municipal ordinances and are heard by Judge Cotter in the Village of East Troy Municipal Court. Initial appearance is normally the first Wednesday of the month and trial call is the third Wednesday of the month.

### **Incidents of Interest:**

On July 1, at 1:28 pm police attempted to stop a vehicle for traffic violations at North and Beulah. When police activated the squad car's emergency lights the vehicle increased speed and attempted to elude the officer. The vehicle was stopped in the dead end of Mitten and Elm St. The driver was taken into custody for several traffic violations including unauthorized use of registration, no driver's license and obstructing and resisting police.

On July 4, at 1:54 am police observed a subject leave a bar on the square carrying an open bottle of beer. Police stopped the individual at Union and Division and spoke with the individual. The individual returned the beer to the bar.

On July 6, at 2:41 am police stopped a vehicle after observing the vehicle and driver commit several traffic violations. When officers approached the driver a strong odor of intoxicants were noted. The driver failed a Field Sobriety Test and a Portable Breath Test showed a .22 BAC. The driver was placed under arrest for operation of a motor vehicle while intoxicated.

On July 7, at 4:20 am police observed a vehicle in the parking lot of a bar near the square to have a paving stone through the windshield. Several items in the interior of the vehicle were also damaged. The owner of the vehicle reportedly was in a fight at the bar with two persons a male and female. Investigation is on going.

On July 11, at 11:50 am police responded to a request to assist a Walworth County Sheriff Deputy to attempt to serve a warrant in the 2700 block of Main St. When officers entered the residence, with permission of a family member they discovered a 16-year-old female naked. A male over the age of 18 stated he was having consensual sex with the 16 year old. The 16 year old was taken into protective custody and the male was referred to the Walworth County District Attorney's Office.

On July 16, at 2:20 pm and individual came to the Village of East Troy Police Department and reported he purchased an old ATV type vehicle. He then put the ATV for sale on a computer list. He later received a call from an individual who stated the ATV was his and it had been stolen. Police contacted the reported owner and impounded the ATV. The ATV is being held pending proof of ownership.

On July 18, at 5:24 am police responded to an explosion at a residence on Ridge Dr. When police arrived, they found a vehicle in the driveway suffering heavy damage from an explosive device. The area was secured and agents from the Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms arrived
