



During June 2015, Village of East Troy Police Officers responded to or handled 257 incidents. This compares to June 2014 when officers handled 233 incidents.




Adult Cases referred to the District Attorney's Office – 22




These cases included Bail Jumping Misdemeanor/Felony, Battery, Child Abuse Causing Intentional Harm and Second Degree Sexual Assault.


Juvenile Cases referred to the District Attorney's Office – 1

As of June 26th, we have worked 25 deployments. We have issued:

1,291 citations
623 warnings
32 OWI arrests

We average 52 citations, 25 warnings, and 1 OWI every time we work.

At the end of the year, I will provide each Department with the total numbers they did individually.

Now for your info:

For those who did not make the recent meeting here is where we sit for next year. \$280,000 for all of us. I do not have my notes handy, but it is approx. 160,000 for OWI, 56,000 for speed, and \$56,000 for seat belts. That will be an average of 10 deployments per month with 16 officers working. DOT felt we were underfunded and overperforming, hence the drastic increase in funding. Our plan is to have it rolling by the first week of October. More to follow. That is a testament to all the hard work every agency in the County has put in to this.


