




Monthly Incident Comparison 2013 to 2014

During June 2014, Village of East Troy Police Officers handled or responded to 228 incidents. This level of activity compares to June 2013 when officers recorded 261 incidents.




Cases referred to the District Attorney's Office – 8

These included 1st degree endangering safety, Neglect of a child and Resisting Police




Juvenile Cases Referred to the District Attorney's Office – 0

Juvenile cases are referred due to the severity of the incident or the repetitiveness of the offender.




Municipal Citations - 14

Municipal citations are issued for forfeiture violations and are heard in the Village of East Troy Municipal Court, by Judge Cotter.



Traffic Citations – 87

Traffic citations are issued for violations of the Wisconsin Vehicle Traffic Codes and are issued for both moving and equipment violations, which include Operation of a Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated.
