




Monthly Incident Comparison 2013 to 2014

During October 2014, Village of East Troy Police Officers handled or responded to 193. This level of activity compares to October 2013 when officers recorded 251 incidents.




Cases referred to the District Attorney's Office-5

In October 2014, these included theft and drug related charges.




Juvenile Cases Referred to the District Attorney's-9

These included Obstructing Police, Disorderly Conduct and Criminal Damage to Property.




Municipal Citations-20

Municipal citations are issued for forfeiture violations and are heard in the Village of East Troy Municipal Court by Judge Cotter.



Traffic Citations-100

Traffic Citations are issued for violations of the Wisconsin Vehicle Traffic Code and are issued for both moving and equipment violations, which include Operation of a Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated.

Attended a Village meeting with the consultant and department heads reviewing IT needs. Coordinated the Yik Yak case with the police department, school district, sheriff's office, Delavan Police Department. Attended a Special Olympics dinner for agencies, which participate in Special Olympics. Met with Town of East Troy Chairman, the Village President Timms, and Chief of Police for Town of East Troy to discuss the possibility for consolidation of police services. Attended a disaster recovery meeting.
