



During October 2016, Village of East Troy Police Officers responded to or handled 268 incidents. This compares to October 2015 when officers handled 228 incidents.




Adult Cases referred to the District Attorney's Office – 11




These included but are not limited to Resisting Police, Intentional Child Abuse and Operation of a Motor Vehicle While Intoxicated.

Juvenile Cases referred to the District Attorney's Office – 1




This referral was for Disorderly Conduct. Juvenile referrals may be due to the severity of the incident and/or number of incidents with the juvenile.

Traffic Citations – 98




Citations or Referrals including Warning Citations for October 2016 – 139
