

Village of East Troy Guidelines for Pet Ownership

Pet Licensing

All dogs age five months or older that are being kept in the Village of East Troy are required by ordinance SEC. 7-1-1 to have:

1. A current annual pet license issued through the village.
2. A current rabies vaccination.

Rabies vaccinations are given through a licensed Veterinary Clinic. Proof of current rabies vaccinations are required before a license will be issued.

How to Obtain a Dog License



Licenses are available at the Village Hall in the East Troy Municipal Building 2015 Energy Drive. For questions call 262-642-6255.

Dog License Fees:

Neutered/Spayed:	\$11.00
Non-Neutered/Spayed	\$26.00
Late fee after March 31st:	\$5.00

Animal owners will need to provide a description of the animal, the appropriate fees, information on whether the animal is sexed or neutered, and a rabies certificate issued by a licensed veterinarian or anti-rabies clinic. *Written proof is required from a licensed veterinarian that the animal being licensed has been neutered.*



Animal Feces

SEC. 7-1-9 Removal of Fecal Matter. The owner or person in charge of any dog, cat, horse, or other animal shall not

permit solid fecal matter of such animal to deposit on any street, sidewalk, alley or other public or private property, unless such matter is immediately removed there from by said owner or person in charge. This Section shall not apply to a person who is visually or physically handicapped.

Accumulation of Fecal Matter Prohibited in Private Yards.

The owner or person in charge of a dog or cat must also prevent accumulation of animal waste on his/her own property, by regularly patrolling and properly disposing of the fecal matter.



SEC. 7-1-10 INJURY TO PROPERTY BY ANIMALS

It shall be unlawful for any person owning or possessing an animal, dog or cat to permit such animal, dog or cat to go upon any parkway or private lands or premises without the permission of the owner of such premises, and break, bruise, tear up, crush or injure any lawn, flower bed, plant, shrub, tree or garden in any manner whatsoever, or to defecate thereon.



SEC. 7-1-11 BARKING DOGS OR CRYING CATS

It shall be unlawful for any person knowingly to keep or harbor any dog which habitually barks,

howls or yelps, or any cat which habitually cries or howls to the great discomfort of the peace and quiet of the neighborhood, or in such manner as to materially disturb or annoy persons in the neighborhood who are of ordinary sensibilities. Such dogs and cats are hereby declared to be a public nuisance. A dog or cat is considered to be in violation of this Section when two (2) formal, written complaints are filed with the Village Police Department within a four (4) week period.



SEC. 7-1-14 PROVIDING PROPER FOOD AND DRINK TO CONFINED ANIMALS

(a) No person owning or responsible for confining or impounding any animal may refuse or neglect to supply the animal with a sufficient supply of food and clean water as prescribed in this Section. (b) The food shall be sufficient to maintain all animals in good health. (c) If potable water is not accessible to the animals at all times, it shall be provided daily and in sufficient quantity for the health of the animal. State Law: Section 951.13, Wis. Stats.



All dogs and cats shall be kept under control. If for some reasons your animal becomes at large, please notify the Village of East Troy Police Department, 262-642-6250. If we have your information we will be able to return your pet. Otherwise, all impounded animals will be transferred to:

Local Dog Parks

Price Conservancy Dog Park is located in LaFayette Township at N6421 Hodunk Road Elkhorn, WI 53121. Includes a one acre plus off-leash canine play area featuring a five-foot chain link fence with double gated entry, picnic tables, benches, hiking posts and doggy mitt receptacles.

Mukwonago Park is located at W325 S9925 Beulah Road Mukwonago, WI 53149. Fenced big and small dog areas. Daily or annual park permit required.

Minooka Dog Park is located at 1927 E Sunset Dr., Waukesha, WI 53186. 3.8 acres for small dogs and 11.9 acres for big dogs to play. Includes grass, benches, and trees, but will need to bring water. Parking fee.

The City Dog Park (Burlington) is located at 480 S. Calumet Street, Burlington, WI 53105. 3.5 acre park is located at St. Mary's Park next to the Fox River and has a separate small dog area. Doggy mitt receptacles, picnic tables and benches. No fees.

Whitewater Bark Park: On Commercial Drive on the northeast side of town. Take Hwy 59 (also call Newcomb Street) and turn east on Commercial Drive. Off leash area. No fee.
