


Monthly Incident Comparison 2015 to 2014

During **October** 2015, Village of East Troy Police Officers responded to or handled **223** incidents. This compares to **October** 2014 when officers handled **198** incidents.




Adult Cases referred to the District Attorney's Office – 4

These included Disorderly Conduct and Issuance of Worthless Checks.




Juvenile Cases referred to the District Attorney's Office – 1




Municipal Citations – 13


