




Monthly Incident Comparison 2012 and 2013.

During September 2013, Village of East Troy Police Officers responded to or handled 249 incidents. This level of activity compares to September 2012 in which officers recorded 263 incidents.




Charges/Individuals Referred to the District Attorney's Office –31

During September 2013, these included Resisting Arrest, Intimidating a Witness for Money, Sexual Assault, and Vehicle Taken W/O Owner's Consent.




Criminal Cases Sent to the District Attorney's Office-4

During September 2013, these included Neglect of a Child, Disorderly Conduct and Criminal Damage to Property.




Juvenile Cases Referred to the District Attorney – 2

These are juvenile cases due to the severity or a repetitive offender, are referred to the District Attorney. In September 2013, these were Battery and Disorderly Conduct.




Municipal Citations- 18

Municipal citations are issued by officers for violation of municipal ordinances and are heard by Judge Cotter in the Village of East Troy Municipal Court. Initial appearance is normally the first Wednesday of the month and trial call is the third Wednesday of the month.

Items of Note:

On September 1 at 7:14 pm police responded to the area of ES and Townline Road for a reported intoxicated driver. Police located the vehicle, observed several traffic violations, and conducted a traffic stop on the suspect vehicle. Field Sobriety Tests were conducted on the driver and he was subsequently arrested for operation of a motor vehicle while intoxicated 2nd offense and driving while his license was revoked.

On September 2 at 8:07 pm police responded to a request for assistance from the Town of East Troy Police. The Town of East Troy Police were responding to a domestic disturbance where a gun had been pointed at the victim and the victim. The armed subject was taken into custody and approximately 30 firearms were removed from residence.

On September 3 at 2:44 am police observed a suspicious vehicle in the area of Beulah Ave and Elm St. On stopping the vehicle the driver advised he was lost and attempting to obtain information from his cell phone. While speaking with the passengers an odor of intoxicants were on their breath and both were under the age of 21. Two passengers were cited for underage consumption of alcohol with one having a BAC of .010 and the other a .015, both were cited.

On September 5 at approximately 2:00 am police responded to a reported disturbance at a restaurant. During the subsequent investigation, police learned of an alleged sexual assault and several liquor violations at the restaurant. Because of the investigation, three subjects were detained and one was taken into custody and charged with 4th degree sexual assault. The restaurant owners were cited with providing alcohol after hours and other liquor license violations. Police initiated a report with the Wisconsin Department of Health and an inspection of the restaurant was conducted.

On September 11 at 11:43 pm police responded to an address on Honey Creek for a reported motor vehicle theft. On arrival, police met with the vehicle owner and learned his girlfriend was intoxicated and had taken the vehicle without permission. When police located the vehicle the driver was charged with operation of a motor vehicle without the owner's consent, operation of a motor vehicle while intoxicated and other traffic and drug related offenses.

On September 20 at 10:30 am police responded to an address on Main St. for a complaint of trespassing. When police arrived, the complainant told police an individual had been residing at her house and had returned there after stealing a computer from a business in Mukwonago. The complainant further stated the subject was on probation and was in possession of narcotics. When police attempted to remove the individual he resisted arrest and was taken into custody. Several charges have been filed with the District Attorney's Office and Mukwonago Police are investigating the alleged computer theft.

Officers:

Officer Rhode completed a sexual offense investigation and see first month school activity report which is attached.

Officer Ojeda conducted firearms training for the department and completed the Tracs 10 installation/upgrade.

Officer Price had several arrests for controlled substances including one off duty.
