



During September 2016, Village of East Troy Police Officers responded to or handled 193 incidents. This compares to September 2015 when officers handled 298 incidents.




Adult Cases referred to the District Attorney's Office – 7




Cases referred to the District Attorney's Office included but, not limited to: Interfering with Child Custody, Carrying a Concealed Weapon and Resisting Arrest.

Juvenile Cases referred to the District Attorney's Office – 0




Municipal Citations – 13


