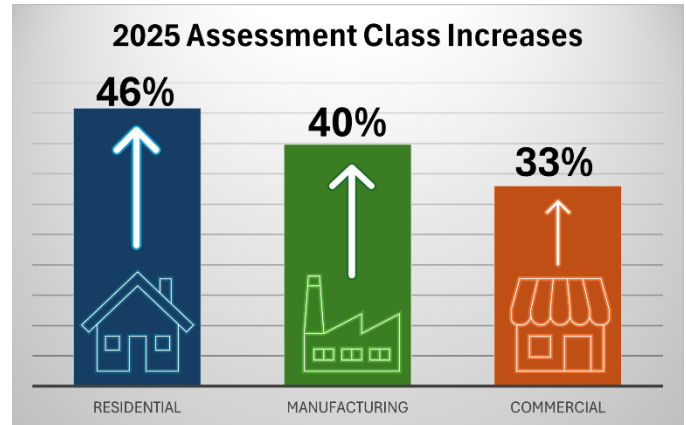


Why Did My Tax Bill Go Up?

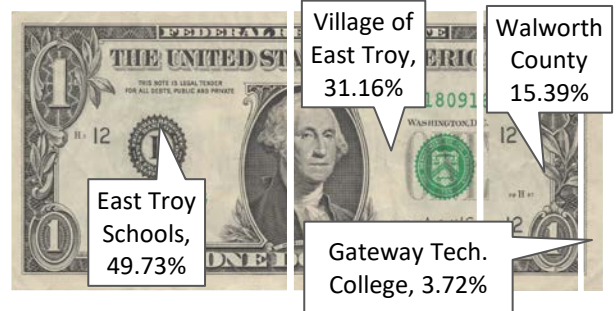
The revaluation does not mean more tax dollars are collected. It updates property values to match current market conditions and changes how the total tax money collected is divided among property owners. In 2025 home values increased much more than commercial and manufacturing properties. Homeowners now carry a larger share of the total taxes collected (levy) even if the levy only increased slightly. Where Does My Tax Dollar Go?

Your tax bill is determined by the levies of the East Troy Community School District, Village of East Troy, Walworth County, and Gateway Technical College.

At the time of publication preliminary levies were used for Walworth County and the Village of East Troy. Percentages are prior to applying any tax credits.



The Village of East Troy uses the Walworth County Tax Collection System which allows you to access your tax bill, print receipts, view your payment history and **PAY ONLINE** in real time at www.co.walworth.wi.us.

How to View & Pay Your Tax Bill Online

- Visit: www.co.walworth.wi.us
- Click “**Property Taxes**”
- Search by address, name, or parcel number

Payment Options:

- **Online:** \$1 fee (bank account) or % fee (credit card)
- **In Person:** Cash (exact), check, money order
- **Drop Boxes:** 24/7 at front door & parking lot
- **Mail:** Include self-addressed stamped envelope or email if you would like a copy of your receipt

⊘ No combining with other payments (e.g., utilities, dog licenses)

Important Information

Receipt Date – Dated the day your payment is received at the Village office. Payments received after business hours, will be dated the following business day.

Refunds – Refund checks will be processed approximately twice a month.

Lottery Credit – If the property was your primary residence as of Jan. 1, 2025, you ARE eligible. **It is the property owner’s responsibility to check for this on their bill.** If you are eligible and do not have the credit, forms are available at the Village Hall to apply for the credit, and we can adjust the amount due immediately.

Payments after January 31 – Please note that **ALL** tax bill payments made after January 31, 2026, need to be made to the Walworth County Treasurer, PO Box 1001, Elkhorn, WI 53121. We cannot accept them at our office or by our credit card service after this date.

2026 Election Dates:

February 17, 2026 – Spring Primary, if needed
April 7, 2026 – Spring Election
August 11, 2026 – Partisan Primary Election
November 3, 2026 – General Election

PLEASE NOTE: For bulk items, residents must call Johns Disposal (262-473-4700) to schedule an appointment prior to placing the items at the curb to be collected. Residents can request one (1) bulk pickup per month. Snow and Ice Removal

Reminder, sidewalks need to be cleared of all accumulated snow/ice within **48 hours** after snow ceases. If the Village removes the snow/ice, you will be charged \$150.00.

Dog License Fees

Neutered or spayed dog = \$13.00
Non-neutered or non-spayed dog = \$32.00
A current rabies vaccination certificate and proof of sterilization is required. A late fee of \$5.00 per dog will be assessed if not licensed prior to April 1st or by 5 months of age. Minimum fine is \$25.00.



Utility Billing






- Issued: Mar 15, Jun 15, Sep 15, Dec 15
- Due Date: 20 days after issue
- Late Fee: **3%** penalty applied if not received by Due Date

Hydrant Flushing:

Hydrant flushing occurs in the spring and in the fall. All areas within the Village may be affected during this time. You may notice your water pressure varying and potential sediment causing water discoloration. *Please check the calendar of events on the website in 2026 for flushing dates.
