**RESOLUTION ADOPTING AMENDMENT  
COMPREHENSIVE OUTDOOR RECREATION PLAN**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of East Troy has a Comprehensive Outdoor Recreation Plan that was adopted May 2, 2022; and

**WHEREAS**, due to an oversight the adopted plan did not include multi-use trails the Village has planned for and is applying for grant funding to install, which were included in the Comprehensive Plan adopted in 2020; and

**WHEREAS**, an amendment to the plan has been prepared by Lynch & Associates Engineering Consultants; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village of East Troy has prioritized projects that contribute to a walkable community and alternative transportation options that promote the health of the community and link points of interest;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Village of East Troy Board of Trustees hereby goes on record to adopt the attached amendment to the Comprehensive Outdoor Recreation Plan adopted May 2, 2022;

**AND, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Village of East Troy Village Board of Trustees requests the Department of Natural Resources to provide eligibility to the Village of East Troy for participation in the LAWCON and Stewardship Fund cost-sharing programs. The Board of Trustees also requests the Department of Transportation provide eligibility for participation in Transportation Alternatives Program or other appropriate cost-sharing programs.

**ADDENDUM 1**  
**(APRIL 25, 2023)**  
to  
**COMPREHENSIVE OUTDOOR RECREATION PLAN**  
**VILLAGE OF EAST TROY, MARCH 2022**

The following sections of the plan are modified as follows:

**Section 8.01.A(2) Walking and Bike Trails:** The Village feels that due to increased residential development, trails linking points of interest are a priority and trail development within parks and nature areas will be implemented as funding permits as a second priority.

The trail extension south from Mill Pond Park to the business park on Honey Creek Road will provide linkage to Mill Pond Park and the balance of the Village is top priority. The trail connecting East Troy to Mukwonago is also highly desired. The implementation of these two larger trail projects is dependent upon grant funding. Trail projects within parks and recreation areas tend to be shorter and may be completed with Village funding while grant funding is being sought.

**Section 8.01.B Capital Improvement Schedule**

**1A.** The trail extension south from Mill Pond Park, approximately 1,950 feet in length, to the Business Park on Honey Creek Road. It is an off-road trail ten feet wide that will provide a safe linkage for more than 450 households on Honey Creek Road to Mill Pond Park and the balance of the Village.

**1B.** The trail between East Troy and Mukwonago consists of both on and off-road segments and will be jointly developed by the Village and Town of East Troy, Village of Mukwonago and cooperation from Walworth and Waukesha Counties. It will be predominantly located within the East Troy Railroad right of way. The off-road sections will be ten feet wide.
