2024 TAX COLLECTION INFORMATION

Your tax bill is determined by tax levies from the following governmental entities: East Troy School District, Village of East Troy, Walworth County and Gateway Technical College. Your taxes are collected by the Village of East Troy; however, the other taxing jurisdictions establish their own budgets and levies. As illustrated in the chart, 32.17% of your tax bill pays for Village services such as police protection, fire and EMS services, street maintenance, snow removal, library, parks and recreation, airport, and other services; 47.95% of your tax bill pays for the East Troy School District for local education costs. The balance is distributed to Walworth County and Gateway Technical College. The chart illustrates the distribution of your tax bill on a percentage basis, *prior to applying school and lottery tax credits*.

Where Does Your Dollar Go?



The Village of East Troy uses the Walworth County Tax Collection System which allows you to access your tax bill, print receipts, view your payment history and **PAY ONLINE** in real time at www.co.walworth.wi.us. On Walworth's homepage select "Property Taxes". We suggest selecting "Village of East Troy" for the Municipality and entering either the address number, street name, or your last name to find the parcel. Click on your parcel number to retrieve the tax information.

Payments are accepted in cash (exact amounts only), check, money order, cashier's check (payable to Village Treasurer) or **online** at www.co.walworth.wi.us. If you choose to pay online with a bank account a \$1.00 fee applies or with a credit card a service fee based on the percentage of total amount is applied.

Tax payments *cannot* be combined with other payments (i.e., Utilities, Dog License, etc.). As always, our convenient 24/7 drop boxes are available for payments at the front door and in the parking lot. If you would like us to provide a receipt of your mailed/dropped off payment, please supply a **self-addressed, stamped envelope OR your email address**.

Holiday Hours – The Village offices will be **CLOSED** on December 24, 25 & 31 and January 1.

Receipt Date – Due to auditing regulations, your payment receipt will be dated the day your payment is received at the Village office. If your payment is received after business hours, the receipt will be dated the following business day.

Refunds – Refund checks will be processed approximately twice a month.

Lottery Credit – If the property was your primary residence as of Jan. 1, 2024, you ARE eligible to receive the lottery credit. **It is the property owner's responsibility to check for this on their bill.** If you are eligible and do not have the credit, forms are available at the Village Hall to apply for the credit, and we can adjust the amount due immediately.

Payments after January 31 – Please note that **ALL** Real Estate tax bill payments made after January 31, 2025, need to be made to the Walworth County Treasurer, PO Box 1001, Elkhorn, WI 53121. We will not be able to accept them at our office or by our credit card service.

2025 Election Dates:

February 18, 2025 – Spring Primary, if needed

April 1, 2025 – Spring Election

Snow and Ice Removal

Reminder, sidewalks need to be cleared of all accumulated snow/ice within **48 hours** after snow ceases. If the Village removes the snow/ice, you will be charged \$150.00.

Utility Billing

Bills for water and sewer are issued Quarterly on the 15th of March, June, September, and December. Bills are due 20 calendar days after issuance. A late payment charge of 3% will be applied to bills not paid within the 20 days.

Dog License Fees



Neutered or spayed dog = \$13.00

Non-neutered or non-spayed dog = \$32.00

A current rabies vaccination certificate and proof of sterilization is required. A late fee of \$5.00 per dog will be assessed if not licensed prior to April 1st or by 5 months of age. Minimum fine is \$25.00.

Hydrant Flushing:

Hydrant flushing occurs in the spring and in the fall. All areas within the Village may be affected during this time. You may notice your water pressure varying and potential sediment causing water discoloration. *Please check the calendar of events on the website in 2025 for flushing dates.
