## Police Department 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter Report for 2023

### Significant Calls/Cases

**Domestic Disorderly Conduct:** In January, an officer was dispatched to a residence for a boyfriend/girlfriend involved in an altercation. The officer met with the female who told the officer the male party threw her down in the hallway, broke down a door, and took her phone, not allowing her to call 911. When officers attempted to contact the male, he locked himself inside the residence. After multiple attempts, officers were eventually able to get the male to comply and exit the residence. The male was arrested and transported to Walworth County Jail. Charges were referred to the Walworth County Attorney's Office for Domestic Disorderly Conduct.

**Bail Jumping:** In January, an officer conducted a traffic stop on the vehicle when they observed the driver of the vehicle failed to be wearing a seatbelt. After identifying the driver, the officer discovered the driver had a revoked license from a previous alcohol related offense along with felony open cases in Kenosha County Circuit Court. Per the driver's conditions of bond, they were not to be operating a motor vehicle unless properly licensed. Charges for Felony Bail Jumping were referred to the Walworth County District Attorney's Office.

**Operating Under the Influence:** In January, an officer was dispatched to Kwik Trip to investigate a welfare check on a male sleeping behind the wheel of his vehicle. Upon contact, the officer made several attempts to wake the driver. The officer was eventually able to wake the driver who stated they were just tired. While speaking to the occupant, the officer noted a strong odor of intoxicants emitting from the driver. After administering Standardized Field Sobriety Test's, the officer established probable cause for impairment and arrested the driver for Operating Under the Influence.

**Domestic Substantial Battery/Disorderly Conduct:** In February, officers were dispatched to a residence for relatives involved in an altercation. The officer met with a female involved who stated another relative threatened her children while they were in the house. The children got scared and ran to a neighbor before calling for help. The female stated she was at work but left to confront the other family member. When she arrived on scene, she admitted to punching the male party in the face. The male was transported to Lakeland Medical Center to be treated for a possible broken jaw. Charges for Domestic Disorderly Conduct and Substantial Battery were referred to the Walworth County District Attorney's Office.

**Theft:** In February, an officer was dispatched to Dollar General for a report of a theft. When meeting with staff, the officer learned a male entered the store, concealed a shirt, and left without paying. After reviewing camera footage, the officer was able to identify the suspect from previous contacts and arrested him for retail theft.

**Disorderly Conduct:** In February, officers were dispatched to Al Smiths Saloon for a disorderly female refusing to leave or pay her bill. Upon arrival, officers met with a female who was visibly intoxicated. Despite officer's attempts to reason with the female and get her a safe ride home, she continued to argue and cause a disturbance. While escorting the female outside, she turned and

slammed the door on the officer. The female was subsequently arrested for Disorderly Conduct and turned over to a responsible party.

**Fleeing/Eluding:** In March, an officer attempted to conduct a traffic stop on a silver vehicle for an equipment violation. Upon activating emergency lights and sirens, the vehicle increased its speed, and drove through a residential yard to evade police. After losing sight of the suspect vehicle, the officer terminated their efforts.

**Theft:** In March, an officer was dispatched to Piggly Wiggly for a report of a theft. Upon arrival, officer's reviewed store surveillance and observed three females enter the store and proceed to the liquor department. The two females are observed concealing multiple bottles of alcohol and other items in their pants and jackets while the third female is seen exiting the store with a cart full of merchandise.

Chief Swendrowski attended Local Agency Security Officer training through the Crime Information Bureau. Chief Swendrowski attended Walworth County Emergency Communications Advisory Committee meeting, Walworth County Law Enforcement Executive Association meeting, Communications Committee meeting, and Records Management meeting.
