## Police Department 2nd Quarter Report for 2019

### Significant Calls/Cases

**Battery and Disorderly Conduct:** In April officers were dispatched to the area of Austin Street at Division Street for a physical altercation between a male and a female. During investigation it was determined the male struck the female 5-6 times in the head. Male was arrested and transported to Walworth County Jail. Charges were referred to Walworth County District Attorney's Office for Battery and Disorderly Conduct.

**Recklessly Endangering Safety/Weapons:** In May officers responded to the Brookstone Subdivision for a report of gunshots. Investigation revealed a residence on Mallard Way was targeted from a moving vehicle. Three shell casings were located in the roadway and collected as evidence and transferred to crime lab to be analyzed. Investigation continues.

**Sexual Assault:** In May an officer responded to Graydon Avenue for a possible sexual assault. Investigation revealed that a female juvenile inappropriately touched another female juvenile. A charge for 4<sup>th</sup> degree sexual assault was referred to Walworth County Juvenile Intake for review.

**Theft:** In May an officer responded to a residence on Graydon Avenue for a theft of tools and lawn care equipment. Owner of residence advised he suspected a friend that lived with him during April was the suspect. During the investigation officer was able to determine items were sold to pawn shop in West Allis and suspect was friend of residence owner. Some of the items were recovered and returned to owner. A charge of theft was referred to Walworth County District Attorney's Office.

**Fraudulent Use of Transaction Card:** In May an officer responded to a residence on Main Street to meet with a female whose debit card was stolen and used on two occasions at a local ATM. Officer was able to obtain video surveillance from bank and suspect was identified by officer and victim. Two counts of Fraudulent Use of Transaction Card charges were referred to Walworth County District Attorney's Office.

**Criminal Damage to Property, Burglary, Theft, and Bail Jumping:** In May and June officers responded to a residence on N. Sterling Circle numerous times for different crimes. A lengthy investigation followed, and a female suspect was identified and arrested. Charges were referred to the Walworth County District Attorney's Office for Burglary, Criminal Damage to Property, Theft and Bail Jumping.

**Possession with Intent to Deliver:** In June the police department received two anonymous complaints of possible drug activity at an apartment on Graydon Avenue. Officers made contact at apartment and immediately observed drug activity occurring. A search warrant was applied for and executed at the apartment. Charges were referred to Walworth County District Attorney's office for Possession with Intent to Deliver.

**Budget:**

No concerns with the budget. As noted in 1<sup>st</sup> quarter report the Repair & Maintenance Service – Vehicles account will most likely go over this year because we had to pay for the repair of the Chevrolet Tahoe that was involved in an accident, but this amount was reimbursed to the Village from the insurance company along with the deductible amount of \$500.00 from the other drivers insurance company.

The 2014 Chevrolet Tahoe squad was sold for \$7175.00 through Wisconsin Surplus Online Auction.

**Training and Meetings:**

Officer Heding attended the Spring Medical Examiners Training, Handgun Qualification and Intoximeter Recertification.

Officer Ojeda attended Handgun Qualification and Intoximeter Recertification.

Officer Price attended monthly Swat Team training, Criminal Justice Instructor Development Course, Handgun Qualification and Intoximeter Recertification.

Deputy Chief Rather attended Effective Personnel Investigation Training, Handgun Qualification, and Intoximeter Recertification. Deputy Chief Rather attended monthly county-wide RMS meetings and meetings in regards to NIBRS reporting. Deputy Chief Rather continues to be involved in the Walworth County Anti Human trafficking Task Force by attending meeting and making presentations.



As you may already know, Tuesday night Officers Knox and Price were called along with F/R units to Sergeant Melloch's residence on Beulah Heights Road. Bill suffered an apparent fatal heart attack and died. I arrived on scene just prior to EMS stopping life saving efforts. Upon my arrival, as Bill's boss, I was met by both my deputies along with Officer Price with a hug. Inside I met with Officer Knox. It was a very emotional night for all involved. Having to comfort Bill's wife Marie and son Andy (Wi State Trooper) was difficult to say the least, but thanks to the help of both of your Officers we got through it. Officer Price picked up Father Lucien for us at the seminary without hesitation, and brought him to the scene. In addition to Officer Knox providing AED/CPR to Bill, investigate the scene, he stayed with Bill the entire time and would not leave his side until he was placed in the Funeral Home van. As you both know from experience this takes hours, and Craig stayed at Bill's side, which is extremely difficult when we all know each other. Both of your Officers prayed with us and assisted in the escort of Bill to the Funeral Home in Delavan where Delavan PD had all roads blocked off for us and over 30 Deputies and Officers formed a cordon of honor as we removed Bill from the Hurse into the funeral home.

I want to thank both Craig and Jeff for their professionalism, caring, and support. Both are true brothers.


