NEW PROGRAM IDEAS

The Department is receptive to suggestions for organizing additional classes and/or activities other than those listed. Suggestions for new programs or improvements to existing programs should be presented to the Recreation Director by means of the phone number or email located above.

RESIDENT POLICY

Residency is determined by municipality. Those residing in the Town of East Troy, Town of Troy and Village of East Troy are all residents. Anyone residing in another municipality is required to pay a non-resident fee.

REFUND POLICY

1. Refunds will be made upon request of a registered participant up until the date of the scheduled class.
2. A \$10 service fee will be charged on any and all refunds requested by an individual.
3. In the event an activity a person signs up for is cancelled, that person will have the option of accepting a full refund or transferring that credit to another activity.

CANCELLATIONS

1. If school has been closed due to inclement weather, ALL recreation activities will also be cancelled.
2. If poor weather conditions develop, every attempt will be made to reach a decision before the activity is scheduled to begin. Instructors will attempt to contact parents/guardians at the contact information provided with any information they have regarding cancellations.
3. Once at a program site, decisions concerning the cancellation or discontinuation of the activity will be the judgement of the site supervisor, leader or game official.
4. It is sometimes necessary to cancel an activity due to school-related functions. The Parks and Recreation Department works closely with the East Troy School District to avoid "short notice" cancellations. Participants will be notified of cancellations as soon as we are made aware of them. Every attempt will be made to reschedule a canceled activity. Notifications will be given to program participants.



